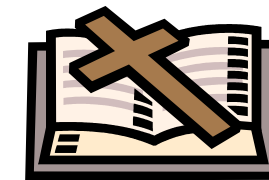


 * Is there anything worth giving up everything else for so you

The Home of the Holy Angels, Uganda
 The last weekend of this month, Fr Charles Nabwana, the visionary founder of the Home of the Holy Angels in Kibale, Uganda will make an appeal at all the masses to benefit this school and orphanage located in one of the remotest districts of Uganda. Fr Charles was born into a family of ten, four boys and six girls. Ordained a priest in 1980, he has worked to build the Home of the Holy Angels since he first caught sight of three small children huddled together on the side of a dirt road in Kibale. The HIV/AIDS pandemic stretched its lethal fingers over these helpless and innocent children, causing so much hunger and pain that my heart wrenched within me. Fr. Charles lost one of his brothers and a sister to this disease.
 Since that day, with help of generous donors in the United States and elsewhere, Fr Charles has built a classroom/dormitory/kitchen and enrolled 60 children between the ages of 4 and 7 into the Home of the Holy Angels. He is providing them a safe place to live, regular meals, clothing, an education and limited medical care. Much still remains to be done, however.
