3. Avoidance of Temptation

We all struggle with the effects of original sin. This means we may feel drawn to what is bad for us.

Unfaithfulness often occurs when we start to believe that a key emotional need – for example, emotional intimacy or sex – will be met by someone other than our spouse, and the opportunity presents itself.

Do not go out for a meal or to the bar alone with an attractive or sympathetic co-worker.

Avoid pornographic websites and be very cautious about online chatting and messaging.

Do not shower all your attention on your children while mostly ignoring your spouse.

And don't give in to curiosity about a "better" sexier, more attractive or more understanding partner! Share your feelings with your spouse. Spend quality time together. And pray together.

BLESSINGS BEYOND OUR NEEDS

And what if the Lord blesses us with resources beyond what we need? The apostle Paul urged believers to work with their hands and do "what is good, that [they] may have something to give him who has need" (Ephesians 4:28). That's the principle of stewardship—sharing our wealth to help others.
