Dear Parishioner:

The treasure pledge sheet is also there for you to fill out. At the end of every Mass we prepare to go back into the World to live out the offering we made and received at Mass. Some announcements are made – opportunities presented to us to live out the Mass. We are given a blessing as we bow our heads. We are sent out “in Peace” to love and serve.

What happens in our lives during the week gives a deeper meaning to the Mass we just celebrated. It is only in relation to our daily lives with family, with community, with work, with school, with sports and with friends that the full meaning of the actions of the Mass become clear to us.
